Membership in LaGuardia Corner Gardens requires a commitment of considerable time and energy. In addition to tending your plot throughout the year, members must attend at least three (3) of the five (5) yearly meetings, usually on a weekday evening. Each member is responsible for keeping the garden open to the public for at least 16 assigned hours during the season, which is from April 1 – October 31. Members are required to pay a one-time initiation fee and yearly dues each February.

Members are expected to serve on committees, participate in community events or outreach, and help with matters of overall importance to the garden, such as snow removal along the sidewalk in winter.

If you have specific skills, such as carpentry, water maintenance or plumbing, legal experience, children's education, community and public relations, graphic or web design, please note them on your application.

If upon considering the time commitment you wish to apply for a plot, please complete the application as fully as you can. If you cannot devote the necessary time and energy to membership, we invite you to visit the garden in the growing season during open hours, which are posted on the garden's website: www.laguadiacornergardens.org. You, your family and your friends are also invited to attend any of our community events, which are posted on the garden's fence as well as on the website.

You will be contacted when a plot becomes available. Turnover of plots is infrequent so please be patient.

If you would like to participate on a more limited basis, such as staging an event or an educational program in the garden, please describe your plan in detail under Comments.

The garden has a Community Area, which is maintained by volunteers who are responsible for watering, deadheading flowers, and weeding. If you wish to volunteer for that program, please indicate that under Comments.
